Squeegee out air bubbles and imperfections



Trim away extra film on the edge of the window frame

Obscure Film

- These window films block
 visibility but will allow light to
 pass through. Some have a
 sandblasted surface, others
 have a smooth surface
- The size per roll has 1.22*50
 Meters, we however cut the meters required.










Block-out films block light and visibility completely. They are ideal where absolute privacy is needed. For example changing rooms






Partial Privacy

- They allow light to pass through and also adds aesthetics to your space




























Oneway Reflective Films

- These window films are reflective in nature.
- They reflect heat and light as well as blocking UV rays.
- They are one-way in that you can see out but the person outside cannot see inside.
- However, at night when the lights are on, the person outside can clearly see inside.










FSY19 Black Both sides











Shatter Proof Window Films

- These are Shatter Proof or Security Films.
- They offer protection in that when the glass breaks it doesn't shatter.
- They are clear with different thicknesses.
